Invite all Utah Public School Teachers to apply for: **State Farm Good Neighbors for Good Schools Award**

Every class that applies has an equal chance to win **\$200** for classroom programs, equipment and supplies. All you have to do is complete the application on the back and cheer on the Utah Jazz!

What You Do:

1. Whether you teach special education or advanced placement in Utah's public schools, you have children with challenges. Sometimes whole classes have special needs. **How would \$200 help you help your kids?** What would you buy? Incentives for a self-esteem project? Science equipment? Books? Field trips? Software? **Be specific but brief.**
2. Describe the challenges your students face and your proposal for a \$200 award on the back and how you would use it. (UEA members may submit 2 different proposals.)
3. Return the application to the UEA Children at Risk Foundation on or before December 21, 2008.

How You Win:

1. Approved applications will be screened for one criterion:

Does the proposal help kids succeed in school?

2. Applications will be selected at random, and put on a list in order of selection.
3. For each 50 points the Jazz score in a game, participating State Farm agents will give the next class on the list a \$200 State Farm Good Neighbors for Good Schools award.

If the Jazz WIN the game, State Farm will name an additional class. Listen to the Jazz games to hear the winner announced!

PLEASE NOTE:

The GNGS grant program is part of a partnership with State Farm Insurance and the Utah Jazz. Grants submitted to UEA/ Children at Risk Foundation (CARF) are given to the Utah Jazz. The Jazz announce grant recipients for every 50 points scored in each game and an additional grant for each Jazz victory throughout the NBA season. Throughout the Jazz season, the winner's names and a grant check for \$200 are prepared by UEA/CARF and then returned to the State Farm's district office. At that point State Farm distributes the checks to the various agents that service the areas of the grant winner's schools. The agents are encouraged to present the check to the teacher at the school—preferably in an assembly if possible. This procedure often takes several weeks and because the Jazz season runs through April or even into June, during playoff years, then teachers can still have their names selected at anytime during the school year and some grant checks don't get delivered even until summer.
