Overview of October 9-10, 2009 Meeting

The entire Transformation Team met again to reconnect and work on overall transformation.

The meeting began at 5 p.m. on Friday, October 9, 2009. UEA Executive Director Mark Mickelsen welcomed everyone and outlined the agenda. The team recapped the September 18-19 meeting, and then reported out on work group and constituent meetings. A report was also made on the 2009 UEA Convention meeting.

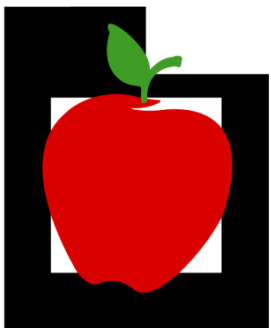
Work groups broke out to discuss recommendations in separate rooms. The entire team reconvened at 8:30 p.m. for a recap. The meeting adjourned at 9 p.m.

The team began working at 8 a.m. on October 10. The first order of business was to discuss the agenda and get direction for working in groups. The work groups then separated to continue discussing recommendations. The groups continued working on recommendations to present to the general membership. The work groups developed separate recommendations, and then reconvened at 11 a.m. to begin the process of preparing the final recommendation documents.

Recommendations were presented in the areas of communication, advocacy, leadership, and membership engagement. These were discussed and presented in complete formats to be presented to staff, the UEA Board, and Council of Local Presidents in November. These recommendations will be available on the website at a later date. A total of eight new recommendations were prepared during the two-day October meeting. This brings to 12 the total recommendations prepared by the Transformation Team.

The next meeting is scheduled for November 10, after the recommendations have been presented to the UEA staff, Board, and Council of Local Presidents.

The meeting adjourned at 12:30 p.m.



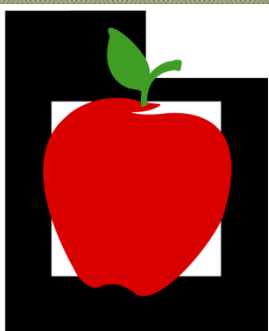
